CURFEW ORDINANCE Town of Lincoln, New Hampshire

RSA 571:9 MINORS UNDER SIXTEEN It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of sixteen years to be upon any public street, or in any public place after the hour of nine o'clock in the evening unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other suitable person. RSA 571:10 **CURFEW SIGNAL** Whistles which can be heard in every part of the city, town or village shall be blown, or bells shall be rung at the appointed time, and shall be called the curfew signal, after which all children under sixteen years shall be required to be off the street, except when they are in the company of a parent, guardian, or other suitable adult person. RSA 571:11 PENALTY, CUSTODIAN Any parent, guardian or person having control of any minor under the age of sixteen years who shall permit any such minor to be upon any public street or in any public place in any such city or town, in violation of this subdivision, shall be fined not more than five dollars, or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both. RSA 571:13 **SECOND OFFENSE** Upon any subsequent violation by any child, said parents or guardians shall be subject to the provisions of Section 11.
